## Completing drainage repair work, and repairing our obsolete pond/stormwater drainage area

As our engineer, Chelsea Moss, pushes forward the technical aspects of these projects (e.g., bids, city approval), the board and committees will continue to investigate and apply for funding opportunities to reduce costs for homeowners.

# Reducing neighborhood conflicts costs and building a stronger sense of community

## Reducing budget expenditures whenever possible

## Planning for upcoming needs and costs
